A13 - Post-Closing Date Disclosure

On the Closing Date, CERH (directly or through its wholly owned subsidiary) will hold the economic exposure to the EU Retention Notes issued by the Issuer for the purposes of the European Union Retention Requirement. CERH as Retention Holder will undertake to retain (directly or through its wholly owned subsidiary) the economic exposure to the EU Retention Notes for the life of the transaction either for its own account or for the account of its wholly owned subsidiary. The aggregate Principal Amount Outstanding of securities which CERH holds (or holds through its wholly owned subsidiary) the economic exposure to on the Closing Date is expected to be £72.645m being the EU Retention Notes which, together with 5 per cent. of the Class XB Certificates, constitutes the U.S. Required Risk Retention Interest as well as a maximum of £197.317m in additional securities which, unlike the EU Retention Notes and U.S. Required Risk Retention Interest, are not required to be held by CERH and may be placed separately before, on, or after the Closing Date.

General Information
